

BSB51315 Diploma of Work Health and Safety

COURSE OVERVIEW

- This qualification is suitable for people who coordinate and maintain the Work Health and Safety (WHS) program in an organisation. It reflects the role of practitioners who apply a substantial knowledge base and well-developed skills in a wide variety of WHS contexts.
- The course covers important topic areas including the implementation of WHS Management Systems, managing WHS risk, investigation of WHS incidents, implementing emergency procedures, managing hazards associated with plant and managing WHS for Contractors.
- This is a new qualification and has been updated to reflect changes and trends in the WHS field. People who choose to study this program will have a genuine interest in WHS and potentially want to work as WHS consultants in their own right.

COURSE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- To study this program, participants will need to have completed the 6 Core Units from BSB41415 Certificate IV in Work Health and Safety or equivalent competencies.
- Equivalent competencies are those below from the previous qualification:

BSBWHS402 Assist with compliance with WHS laws BSBWHS403 Contribute to implementing and maintaining

WHS consultation and participation processes

BSBWHS404 Contribute to WHS hazard identification, risk assessment and risk control

BSBWHS405 Contribute to implementing and maintaining WHS management systems

BSBWHS406 Assist with responding to incidents

DURATION & STRUCTURE

- The course structure allows you up to 18 months to complete the program during which time you will study using a combination of face to face in a classroom, combined with homework (distance) away from class.
- You will complete 1200 hours of study, including 1 day per month in a classroom for 12 months, combined with study and research away from class completing activities and assessments.
- All learning and assessment materials required to work away from class are provided online through our student portal linked to our website.
 This course can also be taken by distance education in its entirety via our e-learning platform.
- Assessments are a combination of written work, oral questiong and project submission.
