



TRAFFIC CONTROL TRAINING

COURSE OVERVIEW

- The Traffic Control Training programs provide instruction and training for individuals who are required to control traffic with a Stop/Slow bat and those who are required to set up and work with Traffic Control Guidance Schemes/Traffic Control Plans at a work site.
- There are two programs which can be run independently or together depending on our clients requirements. We provide training for both Traffic Controller and Implement Traffic Control Plans. All our training is provided for both New Entrants to the market and Existing Workers who may need to formalise skills or recertify.
- The training is either conducted over 1 or 2 days depending on the enrolment and graduates are able to commence work with SafeWork NSW Endorsement for 90 days. Within that 90 day period final assessment on a live project needs to be arranged. Once complete, individuals will be issued with a Statement of Attainment and gain their Photocard.

COURSE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- There are no formal entry requirements or pre-requisites, but we would expect that you have a genuine interest and a desire to work in traffic management. Work can also be physically demanding so consideration must be given to your physical well being and capacity.
- Prospective learners will be required to attain an adequate level of competency in basic Language, Literacy and Numeracy skills before they can commence the training. The liability on the learner, other team members and members of the public in terms of safety, is critical. Participants need to be able to communicate effectively and confidently in English and interpret a range of safety signs and symbols.
- Learners must wear comfortable sensible clothing for this form of training. You will be conducting practical components so enclosed footwear at all times, preferably safety boots with steel cap and durable long pants or jeans.

DURATION & STRUCTURE

- Traffic Controller is conducted over a 1 day period from 0900 to 1700 and comprises class based theory and practical tuition.
- Implement Traffic Control Plans also runs over 1 day from 0900 to 1700 and also comprises class based theory and practical tuition.
- Participants who want both to attain both outcomes will attend the full two days. Courses run every Tuesday and Wednesday in Granville or Liverpool, call to enquire.
- Each course has final assessment outcomes which need to take place within 90 days of the initial training. Graduates will need to find casual or volunteer employment so live assessment can occur. Star Training can not guarantee placement, but will assist where possible.

TRAINING OUTCOMES

- On successful completion of the program, learners will be issued with SafeWork Statement of Completion (SOC). The SOC is valid for 90 days and allows you to commence work as soon as you receive an offer of employment.
- Within 90 days you will need to be assessed on a live project so you can finalise training and receive a Statement of Attainment. We can then apply for your Photocard from SafeWork NSW.
- Your Statement of Attainment is nationally accredited and can be used around the country for the purposes of credit toward further study or as a basis to obtain licensing interstate depending on requirements.

COURSE ELEMENTS

Main Objectives

Stop/direct road users and understand stopping sight distances, using a stop/slow bat.

Understand the Traffic Control Guidance Schemes (TCGS) also known as Traffic Control Plans.

Assess and respond to changes in the environment e.g. traffic volumes, weather conditions, road conditions, Work Health and Safety (WHS).

Use communication methods and devices that include verbal and non-verbal.

Select a TCGS/TCP to suit site conditions, the specific road environment, traffic volumes and work activities.

Plan for emergencies that may arise.

Install and remove signs and traffic control devices, lane closures, advanced information signage in line with a TCGS/TCP.
